With more and more business travelers relying on mobile devices such as smartphones and tablets while on-the-go, the need for printing from these devices is increasing. Frequent travelers are seeking out and booking with properties that offer mobile printing as a guest amenity. The PrinterOn Mobile Printing Solution enables your guests to print easily and securely from wherever they are: the airport, in the hotel lobby or from the comfort of their suite.

The Power of Mobile Printing for Hospitality

PrinterOn gives guests the power to print documents from laptops, tablets and smartphones, to designated printers at your front desk or business center, without having to download printer drivers or connect to your network. Guests can print by emailing documents to a printer's unique email address, uploading documents to a web printing portal via URL, or by using one of the mobile printing apps available for BlackBerry, iOS and Android devices, whichever method is suitable for them.

Document Privacy – The Secure Release Code

PrinterOn uses a secure release code system to keep all documents private. After a document is sent for printing, a release code is emailed back to the user which they use to release their documents. Documents not released are never printed, helping to eliminate paper waste.

Deployment Methods

1. PrintConnect and PrintValet - The PrintConnect is a compact network device embedded with the PrinterOn mobile printing software. The PrintConnect connects directly to a local network or to a printer via USB and the PrintValet keypad plugs into the PrintConnect which allows users to enter a code to securely release documents.

2. PC Deployment - The PrinterOn software can be installed remotely on any networked Windows PC making any printer connected to it PrinterOn-enabled.



A Printing Method for Every Guest

PrinterOn is a flexible solution which offers several printing methods depending on your device, location and preference.

WEB – Guests can upload documents for printing to a web printing portal.

EMAIL – Simply send an email with attachment to the unique email address assigned to the printer.

DRIVER – Print from any Windows application with the PrintWhere Driver using the standard File>Print method.

APPS – Mobile printing apps are available for BlackBerry, iOS and Android devices.

3. Ricoh HotSpot Printers - Ricoh HotSpot Printers and MFPs combine the technology of Ricoh's industry-leading printers with the PrinterOn Mobile Printing Solution. These printers are embedded with the PrinterOn software to provide an all-in-one solution for any location.

4. ePrintit Kiosk - ePrintit, an operating unit of St. Joseph Communications, has partnered with PrinterOn to offer a mobile printing kiosk for hotels. The kiosk can be customized for your specific needs such custom paint and static signage, custom sizes and various revenue sharing plans. The kiosk supports document printing, photo printing, digital signage and custom applications tailored to the hotel.

How Does PrinterOn Work?

Each PrinterOn-enabled printer has a unique email address and URL assigned to it. Guests are able to print from their smartphones, tablets or laptops by simply sending an email with attachment to the email address of any PrinterOn-enabled printer, or by uploading documents to a web printing portal. After submission, a release code is sent back to the guest. Documents are processed and encrypted in the PrinterOn “cloud” and are released when the guest enters their release code on the keypad at the printer, keeping all documents private.
