

PrinterOn PrintWhere 4.5 Universal Print Driver Release Notes

Product Changes and Enhancements

PrinterOn's PrintWhere Universal Driver is a unique and powerful software solution that enables any Windows based PC or laptop to print to any PrinterOn enabled Public, Education or Enterprise print device. PrintWhere eliminates tedious printer configuration and empowers users to discover and print to printers anywhere in the world using a simple and easy to use software solution.

This release of PrinterOn's PrintWhere Universal Driver contains numerous improvements. This release builds upon the existing PrintWhere functionality providing additional refinements and many improvements.

The following are some of the enhancements and improvements that have been made in this version of the PrinterOn PrintWhere Universal Driver.

- **Improved – Proxy Support**
Improved proxy support for connecting to the Network. The modified PrintWhere Network Settings User Interface allows the users to specify the proxy authentication type used for communication.
- **Improved – Special Characters in Usernames and Passwords**
Updated PrintWhere to allow usernames and passwords that contain "special" characters such as ampersand and question mark.
- **Fixed – Duplex Support & Print Management**
Addressed an issue that could cause some print management solutions to count an additional blank page when printing with duplex enabled using PrintWhere. This issue only affected print jobs when duplex was enabled and the output had an odd number of impressions.
- **Fixed – Internet Explorer Support**
Addressed an issue that caused some pages to not print. The issue was caused by certain JavaScript used on some pages.
- **Fixed – Language Support**
Addressed an issue that caused some files to print illegible characters when containing Japanese or other multi-byte characters. This primarily affected PDF file printing when using the PrinterOn generic PS driver.
- **Fixed – Truncated Job Names with Print Management**
Addressed an issue that could cause the name of a document submitted to some print management servers, including Ricoh Streamline NX, to be truncated to 16 characters.
