

PrinterOn PrintWhere 3.8 Universal Print Driver Release Notes

Product Changes and Enhancements

PrinterOn's PrintWhere Universal Driver is a unique and powerful software solution that enables any Windows based PC or laptop to print to any PrinterOn enabled Public, Education or Enterprise print device. PrintWhere eliminates tedious printer configuration and empowers users to discover and print to printers anywhere in the world using a simple and easy to use software solution.

This release of PrinterOn's PrintWhere Universal Driver contains numerous improvements and builds upon the existing PrintWhere functionality and providing additional refinements.

The following are some of the enhancements and improvements that have been made in this version of the PrinterOn PrintWhere Universal Driver.

- **Improved – PrinterOn Print Manager**
The newly renamed PrinterOn Print Manager replaces the previous Printer Chooser. The Print Manager provides a central location to search, discover and manage PrinterOn enabled print services. Numerous small improvements and refinements have been added to the Print Manager.
- **Improved – Print Job Owner Management**
Significant improvements have been made to how PrinterOn PrintWhere delivers job owner information with print jobs. Enhancements ensure greater consistency of job owner information presented to third party print management solutions.
- **Improved – Print Management Integration**
Improved compatibility with numerous print management solutions including Equitrac and Ricoh.
- **Improved – Multi-Session Print Environments**
Improved compatibility printing in multi-user deployments. Addressed a reported issue in which one user's session reports an extended delay getting a printer ready status.
- **Improved – PayPal Support**
Improved support printing to PayPal enabled printers using PrintWhere. The new PrintWhere user interface now supports a resizable dialog providing greater flexibility and visibility using PayPal. Added support for configuring tax rates for individual PrinterOn servers. Addressed an issue in which an invalid release code message was reported when using PayPal and automatically generated release codes.
- **Improved – Proxy Support**
Improved proxy support for connecting to the Network. The modified PrintWhere Network Settings User Interface allows the users to explicitly specify the proxy authentication type to be used for communication with the proxy server.

- **Improved – User Interface and Configuration**

Numerous improvements to the PrintWhere user interface to provide a more consistent and easy to use configuration for users.

- **Improved – Network Communication Support**

The modified PrintWhere Network Settings User Interface allows the users to configure PrintWhere not to enforce strict certificate validation for HTTPS communication. This will allow PrintWhere to deliver jobs to the print servers that use self-signed certificates.

- **Improved – Installation Size**

Reduced the overall size of the PrintWhere download and installation providing a more efficient installation.

- **Fixed – Cover Page Information**

Addressed an issue in which the cover page “From:” field may contain the sender’s email address instead of the supplied user identifying information.
